ACCOUNTING, AUDITING AND CONTROL (ALSO PART-TIME)

AUDIENCE

The Master in Accounting, Auditing and Control is intended for students who aim for academic employment in the accounting, auditing and/or controlling branch in organisations primarily operating internationally.

MISSION

The purpose of the Master in Accounting, Auditing and Control is to deliver financial economic experts of the highest quality. This is achieved by building a programme of both nationally as well as internationally recognised high academic standards.

CURRICULUM

The Master consists of core courses, seminars, and a Master's thesis distributed over several blocks. The courses and electives help you to get acquainted with a wide range of topics that are essential for accounting, auditing and control. The courses Accounting Process Management and Financial Information Systems provide you with a solid background for writing your thesis. There also is a course about Auditing Theory.

Students have the opportunity to choose one of the following seminars: Advanced Financial Accounting or Advanced Management Accounting and Control. For this intensified course, active participation and commitment are obligatory. The Master's thesis is written during the last block of the programme.

CAREER PROSPECTS

The Master in Accounting, Auditing and Control establishes itself on the constantly increasing demand for academically trained personnel in the auditing and controlling field. Career paths include:

- Chartered Accountant (RA, CPA)
- Chartered Controller (RC)
- Management Consultant
- Financial Economical Expert

START, DURATION AND LANGUAGE

The Master starts in September and lasts one year (60 ECTS credits). The programme is taught in English. It is also possible to do the Master's specialisation part-time; in that case you will require at least two years to successfully complete the programme.

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

When you choose for Accounting, Auditing and Control you have two options:

- the master Accounting, Auditing and Control
- the specialisation Accounting, Auditing and Control within the Master Economics and Business.
